From October, 2023 to July 2025, he served as the Consul General of India in Frankfurt, Germany. Ambassador Mubarak is presently the Joint Secretary (Passport Seva Programme) and the Chief Passport Officer of India. He has been nominated as part-time end-user representative from the Ministry of External Affairs on the Board of SPMCIL with effect from 29th October 2025.

He hails from Kanyakumari District in Tamil Nadu and holds a Master's degree in Science from the Centre of Advanced Study in Marine Biology, Tamil Nadu, India. He takes special interest in commercial diplomacy and sustainable development.
